## About Designating Your Gift

If designating to another nonprofit organization outside of our United Way system, list the name of the organization and address. A designated organization must provide direct health and human services in the state of Louisiana, must have proof of IRS 501(c)3 tax exempt status and must be governed by a volunteer board. Designations to religious, educational, fraternal, governmental, political, cultural or animal welfare groups will generally not be accepted. Designations made to organizations whose primary purpose is to redirect funds are not eligible. Should your designated gift not meet the above criteria, you will be notified and asked to redirect your gift.

If you choose to give directly to an agency, funds are paid out based on overall collection rates less an administrative charge to cover processing costs. Agencies can apply these funds to any part of their operation. There is no guarantee that your contribution will be applied to direct services and no accountability to United Way is required with this designation. Please Note - United Way cannot ensure the same high standards of fiscal accountability and insistence on results with non-affiliated organizations.
